Immunization Requirements

In accordance with Utah Immunization Statutes and Rules, for each of your children to attend school, we are required to have on file a certificate of immunization from a licensed physician or authorized representative of the state or local health department stating that your children have received immunizations against communicable diseases.

A child may be allowed to attend school "conditionally" if at least one dose of each required immunization has been completed and the child is currently on schedule to receive the remaining immunizations. Please provide the school documentation of the scheduled dates for completion. The remaining immunizations must be completed on schedule for the child to remain in attendance.

An appropriate Utah Department of Health Exemption form must be completed for children who claim exemption to immunizations for medical, religious, or personal reasons.

If we do not have a current immunization record by August 22, 2017, your child will not be able to attend school until we have one on file. 5 DTP, DTaP, DT, Td, or Tdap

- 4 Polio
- 2 MMR

3 Hepatitis B

2 Hepatitis A

1 Varicella (Chickenpox) – history of disease is acceptable; a parent must sign the verification statement on the school immunization record.

Children enterting Kindergarten, 1st, or 2nd grades, in addition to the above, the following additional immunization is required:

1 Additional Varicella (Chickenpox)

Children entering the 7th, 8th, or 9th grade, in addition to the above, the following additional immunizations are required:

- 1 additional Tdap
- 1 additional Varicella (Chickenpox)
- 1 Meningococcal
